THE ERASMUS BLENDED INTENSIVE PROGRAMME (BIP)

BIPs are hybrid courses proposed by consortiums of universities which aim to promote innovative ways of teaching on topics relating to societal challenges and in a project-based approach.

In the framework of the 2021-2027 Erasmus programme, five universities from the Law Exchange Network (Bologna, Granada, Krakow, Leuven and Poitiers) have decided to develop a BIP relating to comparative law.

In each edition, bi-national student tandems are formed to work on a topic proposed by a teaching staff member from one of the five institutions. The student tandems must work on a research design relating to the topic, in a comparative law approach.

The research designs are presented and discussed collectively during the in-person week in the host university.
